You are also encouraged to bring educational materials and offer demonstrations to the public (such as spinning, knitting, skirting fleece – you name it). Every attempt will be made to provide biosecurity for this area however, as with any public event, we can offer no guarantees. Please review the Fiber Arts Area Rules for more information on the biosecurity measures that will be taken for the alpaca area. (note: no food products will be allowed for sale in the alpaca area)
